**ABORIGINAL RECOGNITION AWARD
(18+ YEARS)**

This category is for Aboriginal nominees in recognition of long term achievements for and on behalf of the local Aboriginal Community and/or Victorian Aboriginal Communities.

**NON-ABORIGINAL RECOGNITION AWARD
(18+ YEARS)**

This category is for Non-Aboriginal nominees in recognition of achievements for developing and fostering partnerships with Non-Aboriginal and Aboriginal Communities.

**ABORIGINAL ASPIRING LEADER
(18+ YEARS)**

This category is for Aboriginal nominees in recognition of achievements towards aspiring to be a leader for and on behalf of the Aboriginal Community.

**ABORIGINAL EMPLOYMENT AWARD
(18+ YEARS)**

This category is for Aboriginal nominees who are working full-time or part-time, who have made a successful contribution to the workforce or community.

ABORIGINAL ACADEMIC AWARD – SECONDARY LEVEL

This category is for Aboriginal nominees attending secondary school who have achieved a high level of attendance and have shown academic achievements and participation.

ABORIGINAL ACADEMIC AWARD – PRIMARY LEVEL

This category is for Aboriginal nominees attending primary school who have achieved a high level of attendance and have shown academic achievements and participation.

**YOUTH SPORTSMAN AWARD
(UP TO 18 YEARS)**

This category is for Aboriginal male youth nominees in recognition of their commitment and achievements through sport orientated activities.

**YOUTH SPORTSWOMAN AWARD
(UP TO 18 YEARS)**

This category is for Aboriginal female youth nominees in recognition of their commitment and achievements through sport orientated activities.

PHIL BRUSCH SCHOLARSHIP

This category is for Aboriginal nominees attending high school in years 11 or 12 who have achieved a high level of attendance and have shown academic achievements and participation. The winning nominee will receive \$1000 to go towards their education.
